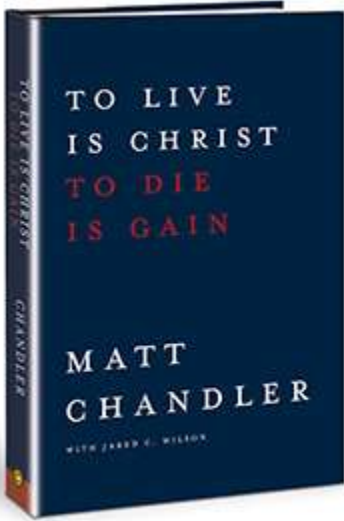


# To Live is Christ, To Die is Gain

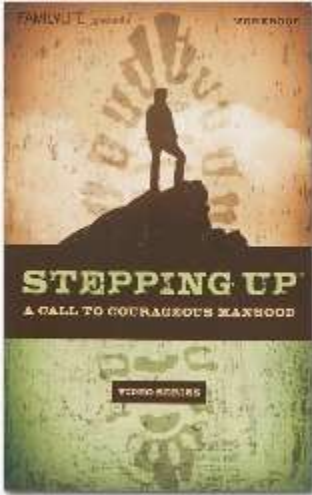

Beth uses Scripture to help identify spiritual strongholds in your life and explains that anything that hinders you from the benefits of knowing God is bondage.

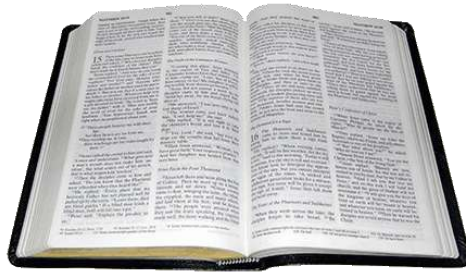
